Gentlemen:

Please remember the first official round of the tournament is at Pine Needles on Thursday, April 19, 2018 at 1:00 p.m. Our package includes all meals from Thursday lunch through Sunday brunch. I will be providing pairings for the tournament early next week. Please remember to bring a sport coat for dinner and your medal. All new golfers will receive Golf Trip medals at dinner on Thursday evening.

I have everyone arriving on Wednesday with the exception of Luis Bustamante, Travis Bustamante, Dennis McClane, Mike Penland, and Norman Templeton.

We have three golfers who are over 65 and will be playing the senior or "executive" tees this year. Michael Wood, Dan Moore, and I have discussed this issue and have also reviewed the score cards for Mid Pines and Pine Needles. On several holes there is only a 5-15 yard difference. However, on several holes, the distance is as much as 75-150 yards. For example, Hole No. 3 at Mid Pines, the white tees are 386 yards, but the green or forward tees are 242 yards. The difference on Hole No. 18 at Pine Needles is 96 yards. Therefore, we believe a point adjustment should occur due to this difference in yardage. Dennis McClane's points, based on years of going on the trip are currently at 14 based on the regular (white) tees. The slope and ratings for both courses indicate a difference between the regular and executive tees of anywhere from 3-6 points. Therefore, we believe that Dennis' points should be increased from 14 to 18. We are using Luis Bustamante's and Mike Penland's points from their recent rounds based on forward tees at area golf courses. We believe this is a fair way to accommodate those golfers playing the forward tees.

Points for all returning players are based on last year's results. McCall's points are based on the last time he went on the Trip, which was 1999. Others are based on known handicaps.

The beginning points are as follows:

There is a \$200.00 entry fee. The payouts for the Trip are as follows:

- Each daily round pays \$250.00 for 1st, \$125 for 2nd, and \$75.00 for 3rd.
- The four day tournament pays \$500.00 for 1st, \$300.00 for 2nd, \$200.00 for 3rd, and \$100.00 for 4th.

This leaves \$100.00 as an administrative fee to be paid to Dan Moore. Dan has spent more than that on medals, pins, and website issues. Please take a look at the website at www.dimpledorb.net.
